Advanced information

On 30 September Ofqual and the DfE confirmed some of the adaptations for exams in 2022.

- [Advanced Information](#) – to be provided no **later than 7th Feb**
- To make exams in 2022 less daunting for all GCSE, International GCSE, AS and A level students, and help them to manage their exam preparation, they will be told in advance some of the content that will be included in their examinations, excluding subjects with arrangements for optionality.



UK Quals exam contingency – Key Information

The Department of Education (DfE) and Ofqual completed a joint consultation on contingency arrangements for the award of GCSEs, AS and A levels in England for summer 2022 in the event that examinations cannot take place.

- either due to continued disruption to teaching and learning throughout the academic year (as seen in 2020/2021) OR
- because of public health concerns relating to the sitting of examinations themselves (as in 2019/2020).

The proposal is based on the Teacher Assessed Grades process used in 2021, with refinements based on learning from the 2021 series.

UK Quals exam contingency – Key Information

- Students should be assessed under exam like conditions.
- Schools should assess all students who are taking a particular qualification using the same materials OR using different materials at different times.
- Ideally 3 assessments should be identified to inform a TAG i.e. Autumn 2021, Spring 2022, Early Summer 2022
- Try not to over assess, assessment time shouldn't exceed the total time students would spend taking exams
- Students should only be assessed on what they have been taught and should be similar to full or part papers that they are preparing to take next summer.
- Students should be told when, where and which assessment may be used to determine their TAG if exams were cancelled



UK Quals exam contingency – Key Information

- Reasonable adjustments and special considerations should be used as normal.
- Teachers should mark the assessments in line with our published mark schemes and guidance that can be found on our Pearson qualifications pages
- Student work should be retained



Standards in 2022

UK GCSE, AS and A Level Qualifications

Ofqual and the DfE have confirmed that

- As in any other year, exam boards will use data as a starting point, to align their standards in a subject. That will be based on an interim point of 2019 and 2021 results. But the grade boundaries for each specification will be set by the senior examiners, after they have reviewed the work produced by students.
- Results overall will be higher than in 2019, and not as high as in 2020. The exact position may vary by subject and by grade.

UCAS predicted grades

- For 2022, Ofqual recommend that teachers use the familiar 2019 standard as the basis for predicting their students' grades, giving borderline students the benefit of any doubt. So, if a teacher believes a student is likely to be on the borderline between 2 grades, they predict the higher one.
